

Instruction – Crepe paper flowers

1.

Fold crepe paper strips (approx. 60 cm long) in half to 30 cm. Repeat this process twice to produce an 8-ply approx. 7.5 cm long strip. Cut this strip heightwise to 14 cm for the outer petals, for additional petals to 12, 10 and 8 cm. Cut a 4 cm deep rounding (see template).

*Tip: The ply can also be cut sharply tapered or oval.
Depending on the size and shape you get a new kind of flower.*

2.

For the stamer, gather a wide crepe paper stripe (approx. 4 x 10 cm) in your desired color together. Fold the four plies of petals apart and individually set it gathered around the stamen, starting with the shortest. Make sure that the petals are staggered.

3.

Tie the finished flower with a turned inwards crepe paper strips (cut 2 x 40 cm, along the crepe) very carefully.

Tip: For binding the finished flower you can used wire, ribbon or yarn.

4.

Spread the petals and bring into shape by stretching lightly.
